

PURPOSE OF THE CLASS

Some people are well-versed in theology but struggle with sharing the gospel with their neighbor or studying the Bible one-on-one with a co-worker. The Practical Ministry Training Course is designed to prepare Christians to live out their faith and serve others through various skills such as prayer, Bible study, discipleship, Biblical counseling, and evangelism. Any one of these topics could have its own ten-week course, yet this class seeks to provide a brief introduction to each in order to build Christians up to engage in ministry in their day-to-day lives.

The main goal and guiding objective is to equip Christians to confidently establish discipleship relationships.

Additional objectives are to:

- Equip individuals for ministry in their local church
- Prepare individuals to potentially serve the church in the office of elder or deacon, as well as other leadership roles such as deaconess or growth group leader
- Invest in leaders who take initiative to influence others through Christ-centered relationships
- Provide practical skills to grow in intentionally pursuing personal ministry opportunities
- Deepen conviction for, and confidence in, using spiritual gifts to serve the body of Christ

- Pray for yourself and the others in the class, that you would grow in diligence and excitement to use your gifts to love the lost and serve the saints in the church
